Application Open for JXN Water Scholarship

Helping local students build a brighter future

At JXN Water, we know that the future of Jackson's water system depends on you—the next generation of Jacksonians. That's why we're continuing our JXN Water Scholarship, a program that helps local students get the education they need for careers in science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM)—especially in water and wastewater management.

Since the program started, we've awarded \$10,000 to four students who want to make a difference. This year, we're giving four more students \$2,500 each to help cover the cost of their education at Jackson State University or Hinds Community College. These schools play an important role in preparing students for careers that

keep our city running strong.



Students from Jackson Public Schools, Hinds County School District, and Clinton High School who plan to study a STEMrelated field are encouraged to apply.

What Do You Need?

- A minimum 2.5 GPA
- Two letters of recommendation (including one from a STEM teacher)
- A one-page essay on how Jackson's water crisis has shaped your perspective

What to Know About Water Shut-Offs at JXN Water

At JXN Water, we understand that times are tough — but paying your water bill is essential to keeping Jackson's water system running for everyone.

We've launched a clear and transparent shut-off process to ensure every customer has the opportunity to stay connected.

If your bill goes unpaid, you'll receive multiple notices before service is disconnected. If your water is shut off due to non-payment, it typically takes 2–3 business days to restore service after payment is made. For customers receiving service without an account, reconnection may take 5–7 days after the account is properly established.
